COLOR	REPRESENTS	BIBLE VERSE
BLACK	<p>The black page stands for sin. The Bible teaches that all have sinned and fall short of God's perfect standard. Everyone is guilty of sin and must pay for their sin! It also is effective to compare the black to darkness, and talk about what it is like to be lost in the dark, unable to find your way.</p> <p>NOTE: Avoid saying "black is sin" or "black is evil." Instead, talk about the color black reminding us of darkness or being unclean.</p>	<p><i>For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.</i></p> <p>Romans 3:23</p>
RED	<p>The red page stands for the blood of Jesus (1 John 1:7) which was shed for our salvation. First Corinthians 15:3–4 says that Jesus died for our sins, was buried and rose from the dead three days later. Jesus died to take our place, and rose again to prove his power over death! It is through faith in Jesus and through acceptance of his gift of salvation that people are saved and through nothing else (Ephesians 2:8–9). Jesus offers the salvation we need!</p>	<p><i>This is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.</i></p> <p>John 3:16</p>
WHITE	<p>The white page stands for the cleansing of salvation. Once we accept Christ, we become a new creation (2 Corinthians 5:17). God saves us instantly through our faith in Christ. He washes away all of our sin and makes us white as snow before him (Psalm 51:7; Isaiah 1:18). This is the promise of God: he will forgive us all our sins!</p>	<p><i>They are reborn—not with a physical birth resulting from human passion or plan, but a birth that comes from God.</i></p> <p>John 1:13</p>
GOLD	<p>The gold page stands for heaven. Some people begin with this page; I prefer to start with man's need and place the gold page here as another benefit of receiving Christ. Jesus has gone to prepare a wonderful place for those who choose to accept him as Savior (John 14:1–3).</p>	<p><i>The wall was made of jasper, and the city was pure gold, as clear as glass. . . . The twelve gates were made of pearls—each gate from a single pearl! And the main street was pure gold, as clear as glass.</i></p> <p>Revelation 21:18-21</p>
GREEN	<p>The green page or cover stands for the Christian's need to grow! Plants need three basic things to grow: sunshine, rain, and good soil. For Christians to grow, the three things they need are prayer, nourishment from God's Word, and healthy fellowship with other believers. All three of these must be present in the life of a believer in order for them to live a truly victorious life.</p>	<p><i>Rather, you must grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.</i></p> <p>2 Peter 3:18</p>
BLUE (OPTIONAL)	<p>The blue page stands for baptism. Blue reminds us of the water used in baptism. When we are baptized, we are telling other believers that we are also members of God's family. This blue page is also a reminder that Jesus asked us to tell others about him, and baptize them as believers.</p>	<p><i>Anyone who believes and is baptized will be saved.</i></p> <p>Mark 16:16</p>
